Instructions for Authors

Authors are invited to submit their original papers, unpublished, in the fields of social and human sciences, such as law, public administration, economics, regional studies, history, international relations etc. Full papers should be submitted in Romanian, English or French and will be published after peer-review, according to their topic, as follows:

- In the collective volume of the conference, edited by a prestigious publishing house (papers submitted in English)

The selected papers will be published in one of the following:

- In the Annals of “Dunarea de Jos” University of Galati. Legal Sciences. Fascicle XXVI, edited by Galati University Press (papers submitted in Romanian or English).
- In the [Public Administration and Regional Studies Journal](#), edited by Galati University Press – CEEOL, EBSCO and REPEC Indexed (for papers submitted in English or French).

The workshops accepted languages are Romanian, French and English.

General Instructions

Extenso/Abstract: (Times New Roman, 12 pt., 4,5 cm up/down – 4 cm left/right, justify)

Keywords: (Times New Roman, 12 pt., 4,5 cm up/down – 4 cm left/right, justify)

JEL classification: (Times New Roman, 10 pt., 4,5 cm up/down – 4 cm left/right, justify) available at the following address

Abstract

The **abstract** should be informative and should present the most important results and conclusions in not more than 300 words in English. Standard nomenclature must be used in the summary and including of references and abbreviations in the abstract is not allowed.

Keywords: Authors should list a maximum of five words, expressions to be used in index. It's recommended not to use words from the title but should not be omitted the obvious words.

Tables

The tables should be inserted in the text after the first reference. The number of tables must be limited to an essential amount and be as simple as possible. Tables should be edited in Word, and not imported from other programs. The tables should be numbered with Arabic numbers. The number of the table must be followed by a brief description of the content. Each column of the table must have a title and appropriate unit. If necessary, add additional explanation to the bottom of the table.

Figures

Figures should be inserted in the text after the first reference. It's recommended to use the same font for drawing the figure, bold is not allowed. The figures should be numbered with Arabic numerals, followed by a brief description, both to the bottom of the figure. The figures should contain a legend to present explanations (the symbols of the points, series etc.).

References

The references should be listed in alphabetical and chronological order according to the first writer, without numbering, and consist of all literature cited only. The references are recommended to be as recent as possible.

In case of several publications by the same author, they should be arranged according to the publication year.

In case there are several works by the same author from the same year, the recommendation is to use A, B, etc. The bibliography will be listed in the language in which the work cited was published (the title may be completed and translated into English).

Citations: Standard form is as follows: (Popescu, 2004, p. 15), (Oprea, 2007, pp. 23-26 etc.).

Footnotes

It is recommended limited use of footnotes.
